




Retirement Day

Our cadets have spreaded awareness among people regarding the rights of girls like birth right, education right, to choose profession and many more which they deserve. This nukrad natak was organised on


2nd October 2021

- It was a Day camp .




24 December 2021

- 2nd class was introduction to Armed forces , CAPF and State police .


